Is the requested information personal data?

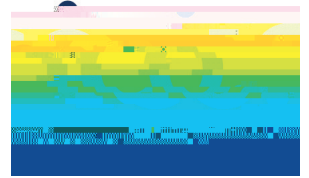




Accountability – members should be accountable to the public for their actions and the manner in which they carry out their responsibilities, and should co-operate fully and honestly with any scrutiny appropriate to their particular office.

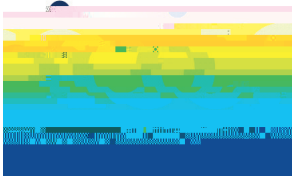
Openness – members should be as open as possible about their actions and those of their authority, and should be prepared to give reasons for those actions.

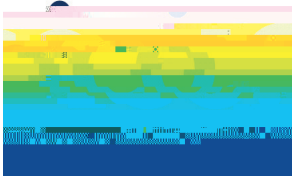
Duty to uphold the law – members should uphold the law and, on all occasions, act in accordance with the trust that the public is entitled to place in them.²

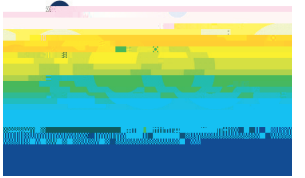


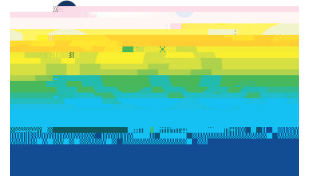
